

## **Code of Conduct for Junior Members**

Shrewsbury Triathlon Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members. We believe it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should show respect, be encouraged to be open, and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club Welfare Officer.

**As a member of Shrewsbury Triathlon Club you are expected to abide by the following rules of behaviour:**

- You should treat all people with kindness and respect – in a way that you would like others to treat you.
- Make it as easy as possible for everyone to train. This means listening carefully, following instructions and helping each other.
- You should speak to others politely.
- You should respect and take care of club surroundings and its equipment. Take pride in your club; encourage and support fellow members in their training & competition.
- You should have a sense of fair play and a good sporting attitude at all times.
- You should do nothing that would bring the club's name into disrepute.

**Anyone who does not follow the code of conduct will be spoken to by the coaches at the session. If behaviour that is not in line with the code of conduct persists, sanctions will be imposed at the discretion of the coaches. Parents will be informed of this by a member of the coaching team or club welfare officer.**
